
OPTIONS TO START


You can start from the curriculum (general skills, specific skills, content) and add the" Community Service" element, or you can start with a project that is already underway in your school and integrate the" Learning" element.






Process Phases of Service-Learning












10 steps of the Service Leaning process

- Step 1. Schools and teachers preparation for Service Learning
- Step 2. Preparing the classroom for Service Learning
- Step 3. Community analysis
- •Step 4. Choosing the community needs/ problems
- Step 5. Integration of learning and community service (including personal learning planning)
- Step 6. Project planning
- Step 7. Project implementation
- Step 8. Evaluation of the community service
- Step 9. Evaluation of the learning (curriculum related competencies and other life skills)
- Step 10. Celebration and dissemination




